TALKING HELPS! PSYCHOLOGICAL SUPPORT OPTIONS



Feeling stressed, overwhelmed, helpless and vulnerable? Talk about it. Reach out to family members, relatives or others who care about you to let them know how you are feeling.

If that is not enough, extra professional help may be necessary – do not hesitate to talk to specialists from the medical, psychological or mental health professions.

YOU ARE ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION!



After a road traffic collision, report your claim to your own or the other party's insurer. This includes your non-compulsory vehicle insurance or automobile club car cover, but also life, health, accident, disability or legal expenses insurance. Inform your own as well as the other party's insurer about the road traffic collision.

You can claim these and other costs through the other party's third-party insurance):

- for personal injury: medical treatment costs, loss of earnings, compensation for pain and suffering
- for vehicle damage: expert assessment, repair costs, depreciation, loss of use or rental car costs, accident-related expenses, recovery and towing costs
- In the event of death: funeral costs, maintenance claims, household management costs

TOP TIP — Get legal advice!



In the wake of a serious road crash, it is important to report any claims you might have. It would therefore make sense to consult a lawyer where claiming liability, compensation for pain and suffering and damages are concerned.

Your lawyer should specialise in traffic or civil law. In most cases, the person who caused the collision will have to pick up all or part of your legal expenses.
